## Post-acute care spending under the Medicare Shared Savings Program

**ISSUE:** Reducing spending for unnecessary or inefficient medical care has been a goal of the Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP). This analysis examines how spending for post-acute care has changed under the program.

**KEY POINTS** Medicare expenditures for skilled nursing facilities and home health care increased at slightly lower rates for beneficiaries in MSSP compared to non-ACO beneficiaries in the same markets. However, the reduction in spending for inpatient acute hospital care was greater than the decline in post-acute care.

**ACTION:** Commissioners will review and discuss the material.
