Reforming Medicare's benefit design

ISSUE: The design of Medicare's fee-for-service benefits and cost-sharing requirements expose Medicare beneficiaries to financial risk. The Commission has been considering ways to reform the traditional benefit package with two main goals: to give beneficiaries better protection against high out-of-pocket spending and to create incentives for beneficiaries to make better decisions about their use of health care.

KEY POINTS: We continue our presentation of preliminary results from modeling alternative changes in the FFS benefit design. We will also consider those results with and without an excise tax on supplemental insurance.

ACTION: Commissioners should provide feedback on this installment of our work on Medicare's benefit design.
