Reforming Medicare's benefit design

ISSUE: The design of Medicare's fee-for-service benefits and cost-sharing requirements expose Medicare beneficiaries to financial risk. The Commission has been considering ways to reform the traditional benefit package with two main goals: to give beneficiaries better protection against high out-of-pocket spending and to create incentives for beneficiaries to make better decisions about their use of health care.

KEY POINTS: We continue our presentation of preliminary results from modeling alternative changes in the FFS benefit design. We will also consider those results with and without potential restructuring of first-dollar coverage.

ACTION: Commissioners should provide feedback on this installment of our work on Medicare's benefit design.
