Primer: Medicare entitlement based on disability

ISSUE: About 9 million Medicare beneficiaries under the age of 65 are entitled to Medicare because they receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI).

KEY POINTS: This presentation describes how individuals become entitled to SSDI, and the spending, utilization and access measures for this group of beneficiaries, including how it differs from aged Medicare beneficiaries.
